



Guidance for Matches

Set out below are the guidelines that need to be followed when visiting Basingstoke Hockey Club (BHC) during this phased return to play. To keep our members, coaches, officials, and visitors safe, please read these guidelines carefully.

All players, officials and coaches must maintain social distancing before and after the hockey match/session. Spectator groups must be restricted to discrete six person gathering limits and spread out, in line with wider Government Guidelines.

All visiting hockey clubs must follow the EH Guidance issued on 7 August and be responsible for their own representatives including spectators on the BHC pitches and clubhouse.

Before each match, teams should notify each other of the Club's Covid Officer contact details and the team's Covid co-ordinator. In the absence of such information it will be assumed to be the captain for adult teams and the coach in the case of any U18 team.

Currently changing facilities are not available at Down Grange.

On match days toilets are available on the ground floor of the Pavilion. Please adhere to the guidance and signage should you enter the building. You will also be required to Scan the NHS QR code for track and trace.

Refreshments will be available on the first floor of the clubhouse and follow the one-way system to exit the facility over the outdoor area and down the fire exit stairs. In inclement weather they can be slippery so please take additional care. To gain access to the clubhouse you will be required to scan the NHS QR code, for those that are unable to use the App and signing in book will be provided.

Arrival at the club

- BHC is an open site, however we aim to restrict access as much as possible in order to maintain social distancing for members and our visitors.
- For a match, do not arrive more than 1 hour before the start. If you are early, please remain in your transport until your meet time.
- **Face coverings are required when using the pavilion.**



Spectators

We welcome visitors to BHC as per the guidelines already stated above. BHC has 2 pitches, both of which are available for spectators. Spectators are reminded that they must comply with the Government Guidelines with respect to Safe Distancing and groups of six (6).

Each pitch has the following controls in place:

Pitch 1 (old pitch)

- Please scan the NHS QR code for Track and Trace requirements.
- Please sanitise hands on entry and exit of the pitch.
- All spectators are to remain on the tarmac and not enter the playing area.
- Do not enter the pitch cage until the previous session's players, spectators and officials have cleared the caged area.
- Do not congregate near the entrance and exit to the pitch.

Pitch 2 (new pitch)

- Please scan the NHS QR code for Track and Trace requirements.
- Please sanitise hands on entry and exit of the pitch.
- All spectators are to remain in the spectator area and not enter the playing area.
- Do not use the seating area, you are welcome to bring your own chair should you choose to.
- Do not enter the pitch until the previous session's players, spectators and officials have cleared the playing area.
- Do not congregate near the entrance and exit to the pitch.
- Follow the one-way system which is displayed with an IN and OUT sign.

Please advise any spectators of the above requirements ahead of your arrival at BHC.

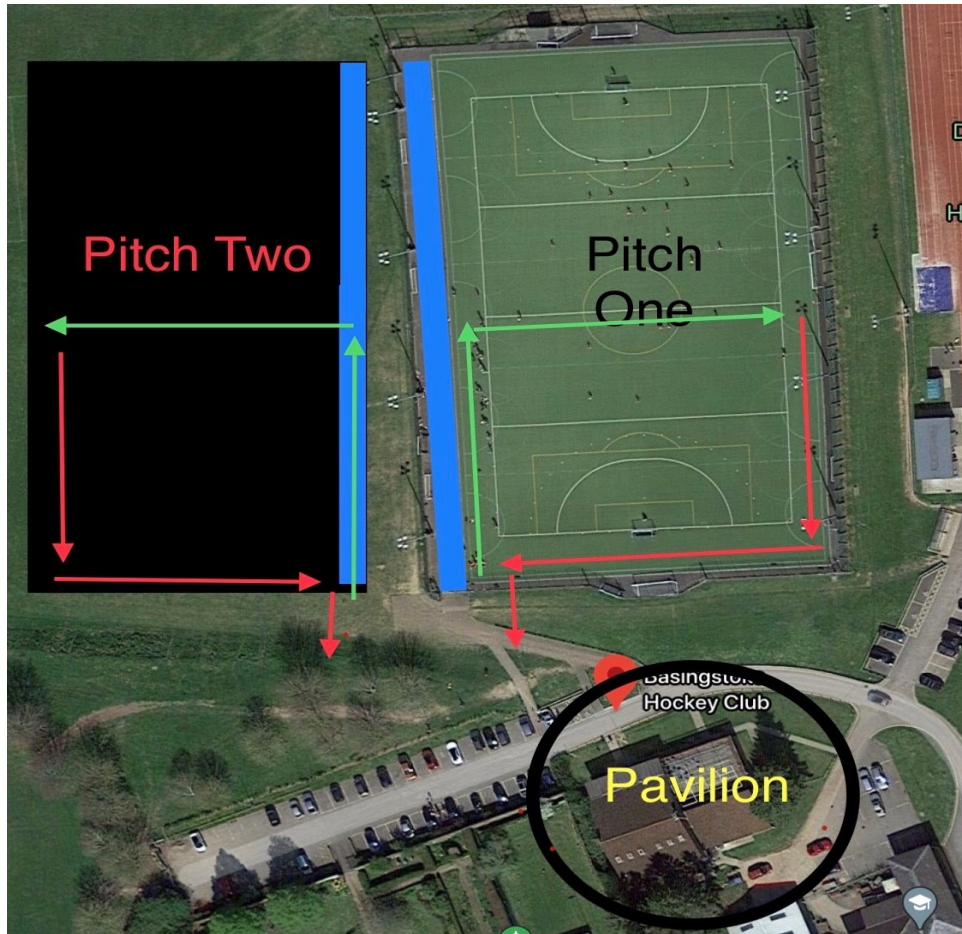
Match Information

- Hand sanitiser is available at the gate entrance, please do use it or bring your own personally named sanitiser.
- As per EH guidelines, clubs will be responsible for their own members, officials, and spectators at BHC.

Spectators must remain in the areas marked Blue and **scan the NHS QR code on entry.**

Players and officials must follow the **green arrow route onto the pitch.**

Players and officials must follow the **red arrow route to leave the pitch.**

On entrance to the Pavilion please ensure you scan the NHS QR code. If unable to do so then please use the signing book
